Travel & Possession Not Permitted Under Any Circumstance



### Summary

- Medical cannabis is not legally available in Monaco.
- There is no established medical cannabis program, and cannabis remains a prohibited substance.
- Traveling with medical cannabis is not recommended and may result in legal issues.

### Background

Key facts:

- There is no medical marijuana program in Monaco. All medical use laws are the same as the laws for personal use.
- In Monaco, you cannot possess any cannabis products with an MMJ card.

Toleration Policy:

- Cannabis is not legal for medical or recreational use in Monaco; it has been described as having a zero-tolerance policy toward drug use.

### Non-Medical Cannabis

- Recreational cannabis is illegal in Monaco.
- Possession, use, cultivation, or distribution of cannabis is a criminal offense.
- Penalties may include fines, arrest, or imprisonment, especially for repeat offenses or trafficking.



## Traveling to Monaco with Medical Cannabis

Travelers must not bring any cannabis-derived products, including prescribed ones.

### Steps to Take Before Departure:

1. Do not bring cannabis-based medication of any kind into Monaco.
2. If using cannabis for medical treatment, consult your doctor for legal alternatives compatible with Monaco's drug laws.
