Travel & Possession Not Permitted Under Any Circumstance



Summary

- Cannabis is illegal in Montenegro for both medical and recreational purposes.
- The country does not have a medical cannabis program, and bringing cannabis-based medications is not permitted.
- Travelers using cannabis medically are strongly advised to consult a doctor for alternative treatments while in Montenegro.

Background

Key facts:

- Medical marijuana is prohibited in Montenegro. The Balkan country does not have a medical cannabis program in which marijuana may be used for medical purposes.

Toleration Policy:

- Personal possession and use of cannabis in Montenegro may lead to maximum fines of 2,000 euros and up to 30 days imprisonment.

Non-Medical Cannabis

- The Criminal Code forbids the cultivation, manufacturing, and trafficking of marijuana, making its use, possession, and sale illegal in the nation.

Traveling to Montenegro with Medical Cannabis

Travelers must not take cannabis-based medication to Montenegro.



Steps to Take Before Departure:

1. Do not carry cannabis-derived medications (including oils, tinctures, or capsules) when traveling to Montenegro.
2. Speak with your prescribing physician about temporary alternatives that are legal in the region.
